The selected consultants should be knowledgeable about Washington State and City of Covington standards, State and Federal regulations, and project implementation requirements. Must have experience in culvert replacement projects, bridge design projects, roadway widening projects, utility projects, environmental permitting, and Federal, State, and County funded projects.
