1. Sustaining Public Art in Covington.


Vice Chair Ed White gave a PowerPoint presentation on this item. Interim Parks & Recreation Director Pat Patterson provided additional information.

ADJOURNMENT:


There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
