CALL TO ORDER

- 2013 Student Art Show: Sandy handed out her final report on the art show. Group discussed getting the schools to provide full names of the students next year for use on the certificates. Pat reported that the certificates have not yet gone out to the schools because Mayor Harto wishes to personally sign all 860 or so.
- Public Art Discussion: It was noted that the group had not yet received any lists of samples to visit with regard to the Jenkins Creek Bridge project, nor a list of the project elements for which we will have some input. Ed agreed to send emails to Scott and Glen to ask about this as well as the Aquatic Center project. With regard to the latter, group expressed the need to clarify “prominent location” for art as described in Scott’s email to Sandy. Group decided to make a motion about the aquatic center project as follows: “The Covington Arts Commission strongly supports the inclusion of a public art plinth in the current aquatic center project. The Arts Commission is ready and excited to collaborate with the project team to provide guidance on the plinth, including citing, size and lighting considerations.” Ed moved to pass the motion and it was seconded by Jonathan; all

approved.

- Art Show: Gini prepared text for an email to go out to the Art Show distribution list announcing that there would not be a show associated with the 2013 Covington Days Festival.
