Project Location: This Capital Improvement Project is located at SE 268th Street and SE 268th Court within the Autumn Bay and Aqua Vista subdivisions in Covington, Washington.

Project Description: This project is an identified stormwater capital improvement project that has received grant approval and has pending project approval by the Department of Ecology. The project includes constructing storm drainage improvements, including conveyance, oil-water separation, filtering and other related work along SE 268th Street and SE 268th Court. to improve stormwater released to Pipe Lake. The project is located within 200 feet of Pipe Lake, and all associated work will occur above the Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM).
