The City of Covington is soliciting statements of qualifications (SOQ) from consulting firms interested in developing an integrated traffic concurrency management system.

Project Description

The City of Covington desires to have a consultant develop a system using current industry standard software programs that work together and consists of the following four (4) components:

1. Citywide Traffic Forecasting Model (i.e. VISUM)
2. Citywide Traffic Operational Model (i.e. SYNCHRO Model)
3. Link and intersection concurrency analysis system
4. Concurrency Report template based on a proposed development
