JENKINS CREEK PARK PEDESTRIAN AND ADA IMPROVEMENTS ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE (ALL SCHEDULES) \$400,000 – \$500,000

Sealed Proposals will be received by the undersigned at the City of Covington, 16720 SE 271st Street, Suite 100, Covington, Washington 98042, up to 11:00 a.m.; local time on Wednesday, May 27, 2015, for furnishing the necessary labor, materials, equipment, tools, and guarantees thereof to construct the Jenkins Creek Park Pedestrian and ADA Improvements.

This Contract is bid in three schedules of work. Schedule A includes the construction of 1,220 LF of paved trail improvements within Jenkins Creek Park in the City of Covington. The trail will be constructed between the west end of the park at SE 267th Place and the east end of the park. The work includes furnishing and installing two prefabricated bridges to span the pond outlet within the Park and to span Jenkins Creek. It includes clearing and grubbing, grading, removal of existing timber bridge structures and concrete foundations, subgrade construction, pavement construction, cement concrete retaining walls, fencing, retrofitting existing concrete piers to support the Jenkins Creek bridge, construction of new concrete bridge foundations for the pond bridge and buffer mitigation planting work. Schedule B includes construction of 400 LF of 36-inch-diameter storm pipe, catch basins, trench excavation and backfill, storm bypass and abandonment of an existing storm pipe. Alternative Schedule A-1 includes 250 LF of paved trail construction between the east end of the Park and 186th Avenue SE. All schedules of the project include surface restoration, signing, traffic control, erosion control and other work all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Special Provisions and the Standard Specifications.

The Work shall be substantially complete within 45 working days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed. All bidding and construction is to be performed in compliance with the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans for this project and any addenda issued thereto that are on file at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Covington, Washington.

The City of Covington in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises, as defined at 49 CFR Part 26, will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and

will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

The Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly after the time and date stated above. Proposals are to be submitted only on the form provided with the Contract Provisions. All Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check, cashiers check, money order, or bid bond payable to the "City of Covington" and in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid.

Contract Provisions and Contract Plans may be *examined* at the office of the City of Covington, local plan centers in the project area, or the office of the Project Engineer, Gray & Osborne, Inc. Licensed Contractors and Material Suppliers may obtain a copy of the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans, free of charge, in electronic format (PDF on compact disk(s)) along with registration as a planholder *only* at the *Seattle* office of the Project Engineer, Gray & Osborne, Inc., 701 Dexter Avenue North, Suite 200, Seattle, WA 98109, (206) 284-0860. Request must include company name, physical address, phone and fax numbers, and email address. Registration as a planholder **is required** to obtain Contract Addenda. Contract questions shall be directed only to the office of the Project Engineer.

A Prebid Conference is scheduled for Wednesday, May 20, 2015. The conference will begin at the City Hall, 16720 SE 271st Street, Suite 100, Covington, Washington 98042 at 10:00 a.m. (local time). Prospective bidders are encouraged to participate.

This project is financed through the City of Covington and through the King County Consortium Community Development Block Grant Program with funds obtained from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Contract will be subject to regulations of the Department of Labor and Housing and Urban Development.

Attention is called to Federal Provisions for Equal Employment Opportunity, HUD Section 3 requirements, and the minimum wages set for in the Contract Documents.

The City of Covington expressly reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive minor irregularities or informalities and to Award the Project to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for Schedule A plus Schedule B, or for the combination of Schedule A plus Schedule B plus Alternative Schedule A-1, as it best serves the interests of the City.
