The City of Covington Public Works Department is requesting interested Personal Service Consulting firms to submit qualifications for providing Right-of-Way Acquisition /Relocation Services for purchasing additional right-of-way from 18 to 25 parcels relating to the reconstruction of SR 516, from Jenkins Creek to 185<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, all in King County, Washington. Work is expected to occur in 2014.
