I have enclosed a Parade Application for your convenience, please complete the application and return it to the address below.

The Grand Parade will be **Saturday, July 20, 2013 starting promptly at 10:00 a.m.** Check-in will start at 8:00 a.m. The **NEW** staging area will be at **Real Life Church** 26201 180<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E. Covington, WA 98042.

The parade route starts at Real Life Church turning right onto 180<sup>th</sup>/Wax Road and right again onto 272<sup>nd</sup> St/Kent Kanglely. The route continues west on Kent Kanglely turning right on 169<sup>th</sup> Place then right again onto SE 269<sup>th</sup> Place (Kohl's Parking Lot). Parade participants, family and friends will **not** be allowed to park in the church parking lot nor in the Kohl's parking lots. Please make arrangements for drop-off and relocating any vehicles. We will enforce this upon check-in. Out of respect for Real Life Church and Kohl's, we ask that you please be sure to pick up your trash (if any) upon departure.

After the parade, please have some members of your group stick around for the parade awards announcement. The **Parade Awards** presentation for the best in various categories will be held at the Main Stage of the festival in the Kohl's parking lot immediately following the parade, or roughly about 11:30 a.m.
