

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, DECLARING ONE MOWER AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT MOWER.

WHEREAS, the City of Covington maintains a vehicle fleet to complete city business; and

WHEREAS, the city has a vehicle replacement program to replace vehicles and equipment on a scheduled basis to maintain a functioning fleet; and

WHEREAS, the city owns a 2005 Walker Mower (Asset #3371) that is scheduled for replacement in 2016; and


WHEREAS, the city's Financial Management Policies require that vehicles and equipment be surplused by City Council resolution; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Covington, King County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby declare that the 2005 Walker Mower (Asset #3371) is surplus to the needs of the city, and authorizes disposal of the mower in the most cost effective manner. The City Council further authorizes the use of the equipment replacement funds to purchase a replacement mower as needed.


