Volunteer at Covington City Hall - it's a great place to work and learn about city government. You will receive volunteer training to assist our staff with various duties either in the office or out in the field, with a variety of departments to choose from: Receptionist, Public Works, or Public Records.

Volunteers must be at least 16 years and dependable. Public Works Maintenance Division will accept eight hours or more of manual labor for community service work. The minimum commitment for all office volunteers is two hours after school, one day a week, for three months or during the summer.
