



THE CITY OF COVINGTON IS RECRUITING INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN SERVING IN THE CAPACITY OF ARTS COMMISSIONER, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCILMEMBER, AND PLANNING COMMISSIONER.

The following volunteer opportunities are available:

- **Arts Commission** – Applicants may be adults or youth (14-18 years of age) who live or work inside of Covington city limits. Applicants may live outside of city limits, but must live within a three-mile radius. One position open is a three-year term. The other position open is a replacement position with one-year remaining in the term. The Arts Commission meets the second Thursday of each month at 6:30 p.m. with occasional special meetings and workshops. Applications are being accepted until both vacant positions are filled. Interview date(s) will be determined.
- **Covington Economic Development Council (CEDC)** - Composed of twelve members. Five members shall be appointed by the City Council and five members shall be appointed by the Chamber Board of Directors. These ten members shall all be voting members. In addition, there shall be one ex-officio member (non voting) appointed from the City staff by the City Manager and one ex-officio member(non voting) appointed by the Board. Three positions are open for appointment by the City Council. All three positions are for two-year terms. The CEDC meets the fourth Thursday of each month at 6:00 p.m. with occasional special meetings. Applications are being accepted until Thursday, June 30, at 5:00 p.m. Interviews are tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, July 12, early evening hours before the regularly scheduled Council meeting.
- **Planning Commission** – Applicants may live inside or outside of Covington city limits. However, applicants living outside of city limits must live within a three-mile radius. Both positions open are replacement positions with one-year remaining in the term. One position **may** be filled with a person living outside the city limits. The other position **must** be filled with a person living **inside the city limits**. The Planning Commission meets the first and third Thursdays of the month at 6:30 p.m. Questions concerning this commission should be directed to Community Development Director Richard Hart at 253-480-2441 or rhart@covingtonwa.gov. Applications are being accepted until Thursday, June 30, at 5:00 p.m. Interviews are tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, July 12, early evening hours before the regularly scheduled Council meeting.
