## Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....



- **TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 for extra tires off rim. \$3.00 for each passenger tire on rim. \$9 charged for each large truck tire and \$18 charged for each truck tire on rim (*cash only*). No oversized tires accepted.
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle batteries accepted.
- **BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell batteries. Also accepted are rechargeable batteries and cellphone batteries.

- **CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENT SHREDDING:** Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Limit 4 file-size boxes. No exceptions.
- **CARDBOARD:** Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- **HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING:** Clothing and miscellaneous household items in good condition. Items in need of repair will not be accepted.
- **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** \$15 charge (*cash only*). Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.
- **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. \$5 charge (*cash only*).
- **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. No peg board, particle or press board. No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, or brush. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.
- **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (**drained of oil and gasoline**), appliances, metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, washers & dryers, dishwashers, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. \$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (*cash only*). Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts, and sealed drums will not be accepted.
- **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** \$30 (*cash only*) will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$35 (*cash only*) will be charged for each household air conditioner. **Please be prepared to pay at event entrance.**
- **MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS:** Mattresses and box springs, any size. \$15 per mattress (*cash only*) and \$15 per box spring (*cash only*). Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.

- **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones (**remove personal information**) and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice. Computer monitors and televisions will not be accepted. You can recycle these items for free at other locations - see the E-Cycle box below for more information.

**PLEASE NOTE: MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE will not be accepted. Please bring this material to the Auburn Wastemobile at the Outlet Collection Mall (formerly the Auburn Supermall).**

**PLEASE ALSO NOTE: STYROFOAM BLOCKS AND PACKING PEANUTS will not be accepted. This material can be self hauled to Styro Recycle located at 23418 68th Ave S, Kent, WA - (253) 838-9555. Check out <http://www.styrorecycle.com>.**

- These household wastes:**
- No construction/demolition debris
  - No garbage
  - No furniture
  - No plastic toys, hoses, etc.
  - No window glass

- These hazardous wastes:**
- NO MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE
  - No paint of any kind
  - No solvents or thinners
  - No pesticides/herbicides
  - No household chemicals
  - No cleaning products
  - No fluorescent lights

**Household Hazardous Wastes (but not latex paint) can be taken to the Auburn Wastemobile at the Outlet Collection (formerly the Auburn Supermall) every Saturday and Sunday from 10 am to 5 pm (except major holidays). Also the roving Wastemobile will visit Covington on June 7, 8, and 9, 2019. Hours are from 10 am to 5 pm. Location: Kent Fire Station #75 - 15635 SE 272nd St, Kent, WA, 98042. Volume restrictions apply. Please segregate motor oil from all other fluids.**

Use E-Cycle Washington sites for computers, computer monitors, laptops, and televisions. Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit [1800recycle.wa.gov](http://1800recycle.wa.gov) to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. In the Covington area you may drop off computers, computer monitors, laptops, portable DVD players, and televisions at no charge at the following locations: Goodwill Maple Valley Store (27077 Black Diamond Road SE, Maple Valley, 253-573-6708) and Goodwill Kent Store (25814 102nd Place SE, Kent, 253-573-6708). Note - drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at the City Recycling Collection Events. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.
