



Changes to the Sign Code

**New Code
Effective
Nov. 1**



The Covington City Council recently adopted a new sign code affecting the display of temporary and permanent signs within the city which will be effective November 1, 2018.

In accordance with Covington Municipal Code (CMC) chapter 18.55, temporary commercial signs displayed in the public right-of-way will require a temporary sign permit. It is anticipated that permit implementation will begin early January 2019. While the city is finalizing the permit process for these types of signs, a permit will not be required; however, the display of temporary commercial signs in public right-of-way must abide by all other newly adopted CMC regulations.
