For a Vendor to conduct a
Automated Pavement Condition Assessment for the City of Covington

The City of Covington is requesting proposals from vendors with experience in conducting automated pavement condition assessments.

The City of Covington is looking for a specialized vendor to conduct an Automated Pavement Condition Assessment (APCA) for approximately 75 centerline miles (160 lane miles) and import the pavement condition information into MicroPAVER. This information will be integrated into the City's Geographic Information System (GIS).

The City of Covington encourages disadvantaged, minority and women-owned vendors to respond.
